- I. **Asymptomatic**
- II. **Mild** – Various symptoms of COVID without shortness of breath, dyspnea, or abnormal chest imaging
- III. **Moderate** – Evidence of lower respiratory disease by clinical assessment or imaging, and oxygen saturation of $\geq 94\%$ on room air
- IV. **Severe** – Respiratory frequency >30 breath per minute, oxygen saturation $<94\%$ on room air*, or lung infiltrates $>50\%$
- V. **Critical** – Respiratory failure, septic shock, and/or multiple organ failure
